

Want to move forward quickly with treatment? Our Fast Track Program is designed for patients who are ready to begin Intrauterine Insemination (IUI) or In Vitro Fertilization (IVF) as soon as possible and want to make the most of their initial consultation.

Unlike the traditional process—where diagnostic testing is typically ordered after your first visit—the Fast Track Program ensures essential fertility tests are completed before your consultation. This allows your physician to review your results during your very first appointment and, in many cases, create a customized treatment plan right away.

By accelerating the diagnostic process, Fast Track empowers you to move forward with treatment promptly and with confidence.

How to Enroll

If you're interested in the Fast Track Program, call 858-552-9177. A clinical liaison will help coordinate your testing and ensure everything is in place for your consultation. Please note: some insurance plans may require prior authorization before testing.

Fast Track Diagnostic Testing Includes:

- Semen Analysis
- Cycle Day 3 Follicle Stimulating Hormone & Estradiol (FSH/E2)
- Anti-Müllerian Hormone (AMH)
- Infectious Disease Screening (for both partners)
- Preconception Screening (for female patients)

Questions to Ask Your Doctor

This is your opportunity to learn and get clarity. Here are a few helpful questions you may want to ask:

- Based on my history, what might be causing difficulties in conceiving?
- What tests do you recommend, and why?
- What are the possible treatment paths based on my goals?
- What can I be doing outside of the clinic to support my fertility?
- How soon can we get started?

How to Prepare

To make the most of your visit, consider the following steps before your appointment:

Gather medical records

Bring past lab results, imaging, or fertility treatments.

Track your cycle

If menstruating, note details like cycle length, ovulation, and symptoms.

Bring your partner (if applicable)

Their history and support are valuable.

Write down questions

It's easy to forget in the moment, so come with notes.

List medications & supplements

Knowing what you're taking helps us guide you safely.



What Comes Next

After your consultation, your doctor may recommend a series of diagnostic tests such as hormone panels, ultrasounds, semen analysis, or an HSG (a special X-ray to check the uterus and fallopian tubes). Once results are in, your physician will meet with you again to discuss the findings and lay out next steps.
